

Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme
For the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities

In line with the Government's Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities ("the Scheme") and to promote a caring and inclusive society, beneficiaries can travel with our ferry services at HK\$2 per trip anytime. Since the Scheme does not include resident bus services, our bus services do not provide the subject concession fare.

Beneficiaries include elderly people aged 65 or above, and recipients under the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance Scheme aged between 0 and 64 with 100% disabilities and recipients of Disability Allowance in the same age group. To enjoy the concession, elderly persons must use Elder Octopus or Personalised Octopus and eligible persons with disabilities must use Personalised Octopus with "Persons with Disabilities Status". Under provision of the Scheme, beneficiaries could not pay the fare in cash. If beneficiaries cannot provide the aforesaid Octopus cards, the fare must be paid in original adult fare.

The Scheme aims to provide fare concession to all eligible beneficiaries in Hong Kong. Those residents, tenants and organisations of Ma Wan and Park Island have registered their Octopus cards in our company need not to register again.
